Once a new member creates their account and/or a returning member renews their membership, the Membership Application, Minor's Release (and Transfer Request Form, if applicable), are computer generated and you will need to print them.

1 – Transferring **High School Members**

If transferring from another district you must first submit a transfer request and letter to the district secretary at ihstra3@gmail.com, she will then send to the transfer committee and let you know if you are accepted so you can continue with your transfer paperwork.

State Transfer

If transferring from out of state, must fill out a state transfer form located on the NHSRA website, obtain signature from state presidents and send letter/email explaining reason for transfer. The District 3 board will then vote on transfer. Then send form to Idaho High School Rodeo President and then upload document of NHSRA website.

JUNIOR HIGH STUDENTS DO NOT NEED TO FILL OUT TRANSFER DOCUMENT – THEY CAN CHOOSE THEIR DISTRICT

2 - Membership Application: **For ALL Members**

The Membership Application must be signed by the member and both parents or legal guardian. If only one parent is signing the form, they must note the reason on the signature line. For example, DECEASED, SOLE CUSTODY, DIVORCED AND FULL CUSTODY, etc. Handwritten signatures required. This information is contained on the bottom of the Membership Application. For legal purposes, we will not accept paperwork without the appropriate signatures. After getting all signatures on the application, **upload to your NHSRA Account.**

3 - Minor's Release : **For ALL Members**

The Minor's Release must be signed by the member and both parents or legal guardian before a notary public. Once again, if only one parent is signing the form, they must note the reason on the signature line. For example, DECEASED, SOLE CUSTODY, DIVORCED AND FULL CUSTODY, etc. Handwritten signatures required. If a member appears before a notary to sign their Minor's Release and the notary refuses to notarize the member's signature because the member does not have a government issued legal identification, this needs to be noted on the Minor's Release by the notary. The member is still required to sign the Minor's Release. For legal purposes, we will not accept paperwork without the appropriate signatures. **After all have signed before a notary public (and indicated as such on the application),**

upload to your NHSRA Account.

Note: Returning Members.... NHSRA Membership # is same as "last" year

4 - Grade Policy: For All Members

Idaho Grade Policy - Print from district website - Complete – Contestant and both parents must sign and date.

Upload to NHSRA Acct

5 - Most recent Semester Grade Report: For All Members

New Members: Request from your school. This must be stamped by the school.

Active/Returning Members: Request from your school. This must be stamped by the school.

This must be your last semester *report card*. If your school does not send report cards, you will need to request one - PROGRESS REPORTS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE

6 - Concussion Acknowledgement Form: Freshmen & New Members Only

Concussion Acknowledgement Form - Print from district website - Complete - *Upload to NHSRA Acct*

7 - Copy of Birth Certificate or State issued ID: Freshmen & New Members Only Upload to NHSRA Acct

8 - National and State Dues: For All Members

\$185.74 - Paid online when completing your membership

9 - Waived until Spring – Report Card & Certification of Eligibility: For All Members

This must be your semester *report card*. If your school does not send report cards,

you will need to request one - PROGRESS REPORTS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE

Certificate of Eligibility – Print from district website - Give to your School Official to complete – *Mailed both (report card and COE) to Donna*

10 – Minimum \$200 Sponsor Money: All Members

Required \$200 to the district awards funds and other rodeo expenses.

11 – \$150 Raffle Ticket Money: High School Members

Required state scholarship fundraiser, must prepay for tickets received in the spring
